The committee has decided to follow the decision UGC and government of India to eligibility criteria for reservation for SC/ST/OBC in higher Education. In 2016 the UGC grants commission for SC/ST/OBC in higher has informed that the candidate belonging to the Scheduled castes scheduled Tribe and other backward classes categories, who have secured at least 50 percent marks (without rounding off) in master degree or equivalent examination for Universities or Institutions recognized by UGC are eligible for appearing in the national eligibility test 2016 UGC prescribes 5 percent relaxation in minimum eligibility marks of 55 percent marks for candidate belonging to SC, ST and OBC categories for direct recruitment are available.

We follow issued instructions of UGC from time to time was deemed to the Universities for

- 1) Implementation of SC/ST/OBC reservation policy
- 2) Display of UGC poster in college website and filling up of remaining identified backlog vacancies of this categories in teaching and non teaching post.
