Merit scholarship to collage/professional institutions students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Mm.

- The objective of the scheme is to encourage SC/ST/OBC students to continue their studies at collage level by providing them a scholarship so as to reduce financial burden on their parents, because spread of higher education along with development of merit amongst the SC/ST communities is one of the priority programmes of the Govt. of India of Delhi. From the FY 2016-17 the applications under this scheme are invited online through e-distric portal.

- ① General course up to graduate level a. Day scholar PM 420 b. Hostlers PM 840 (ii) Post graduate studies in Arts and commerce subject a) Day scholars PM 630 b. Hostlers PM 1110. Eligibility criteria & student is allowed to avail the scholarship either under the state scheme or centrally sponsored scholarship scheme, whichever is beneficial to him/her but can apply under only one of them (a) The SC/ST/OBC/Mm. student getting stipend from the institutions/Government during the course of study are also eligible to get merit scholarship.
